
FRANKE Minerva Boiling Handle Valve Change Guide

- The tools you will need
- 1. Pozi head screwdriver
- 2.17mm AF spanner.
- 3. 22mm AF spanner.

- 1. Switch off the mains electricity supply to the boiler.
- 2. Locate the shut-off valve with the green handle adjacent to the inlet of the filter housing and turn off the mains water supply to the tank.
- 3. Turn the boiling water handle to the "ON" position for a few seconds to release the pressure in the system.
- 4. Use a small screwdriver or craft knife to carefully to remove the end cap (1) using the slot in the handle's face.
- 5. Unscrew retaining screw (2) and washer (3) anti clockwise using a Pozi head screwdriver.
- 6. Pull handle (4) away from the tap body.
- 7. Pull plastic insert (5) out of tap body.
- 6. Pull spring and driving ring assembly (6) off the valve (7).
- 7. Unscrew valve from body anti clockwise using 17mm AF spanner.



- 1. Screw new valve (8) into body using 22mm AF spanner.
- 2. Push plastic insert back into valve bore. Important Note ensure that slot on plastic insert is facing upwards.

- 3. Push handle back onto body.
- 4. Screw retaining screw and washer back into valve.
- 5. Push end cap back into handle.
- 6. Turn the water supply back on and check for leaks.
- 7. Switch on the mains electricity supply to the boiler.



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
